- Jr. Ambassador Program:** New curriculum developed by this year's Ambassadors, and the perfect teaching opportunity for Senior Teen Council members. The curriculum is designed to teach 6-8th grade students leadership skills, confidence building, and prepare them for involvement in leadership programs such as teen council regional and county ambassadors.
- Lights, Camera, Cooking:** Learn how to help youth film and star in their own cooking show. Activities center on kids learning about cooking, how to give a demonstration, the steps needed to prepare food. Kids will have the opportunity to write their script, film with a digital Flip camera, and then to import those video clips to a laptop and assemble them to create a video.
- Crime & Spy Science:** Develop your leadership skills and learn to help youth discover how detectives use science to uncover the mysteries of a crime. Teach youth to solve the case of "The Murder of Professor Half Track" using clues, and conduct their own biotechnology experiments to solve the murder mystery.
