

## WHO'S THE GUEST

**Items Needed:** Index card and pencil per player

Divide your group in half, and have one team sit opposite the other team.

Give each person an index card and a pencil. Have each person write his/her name at the top of the card. Then each person should secretly list 5 little-known facts about themselves. For example, "played trombone in high school", "has lived in Hawaii twice", "has lived in 6 houses", "likes to run", etc.

Gather the cards from each team, keeping each team's cards separate. Read a card from Team A and have the players on team B guess who from Team A wrote the card. If the person is guessed on clue 1, give the guessing team 5 points. If the person is guessed on clue 2, give 4 points; clue 3, 3 points; clue 4, 2 points; and clue 5, 1 point. Read all 5 clues even if the person is guessed because it is fun to learn about each person. Then read a card from team B and have Team A guess. Continue until all the cards are read.
